### **WALK. WATCH. Don't Talk!**

Pedestrians, just like drivers, should remain attentive and avoid distractions.

- Keep an eye out as you walk, look and listen.
- If you see an unattended child in a vehicle, call 911

### **Always Look Before You Lock**

Secure your phone, purse or briefcase in the back next to your car seat to ensure you look in the back before heading into the office.

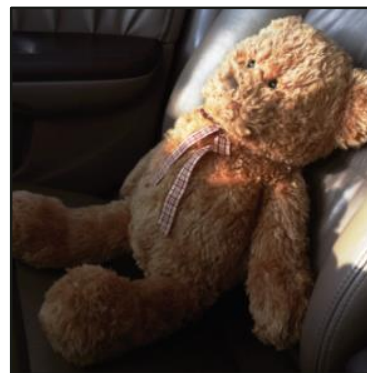
- Make it a routine to open the back door of your car every time you park.
- If someone else is driving, or your daily routine has been altered, check to make sure your child has arrived safely.
